
# Choosing an Egg




## NUTCASE STUDIES

Likes a challenge and feeling the wind in her hair. She's down-to-earth but enjoys climbing, chocolate


Lightning Bolt (Boltus Fugit) Characteristics – Fast, energetic and exhausting to be with.
