Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the second half of the Autumn Term - I hope you had a relaxing half term break.

Class 1 have a new half term theme about dragons. I look forward to seeing their work on these in the next few weeks. They have also been on a shape hunt around the school and at the church. Some of the shapes they have found are quite amazing. Well done.

Class 2 pupils have been writing collective remembrance poems, taken part in a fun interactive times tables practice and discussed blueprints for fiction story writing e.g. A Quest, Voyage & Return, Rags to Riches, Comedy and Tragedy are just a few.

This week, along with the other schools in the federation, we celebrated our first "Ready, Steady, Write" day. These days, which we hope to make a regular feature of school life, are an opportunity for children to explore and write about a particular theme, which will usually be based around a familiar rhyme or traditional story. We ended the day with a special sharing assembly, in which the children were able to read their work and talk about the day. We also enjoyed hearing some of the staff read their writing.
