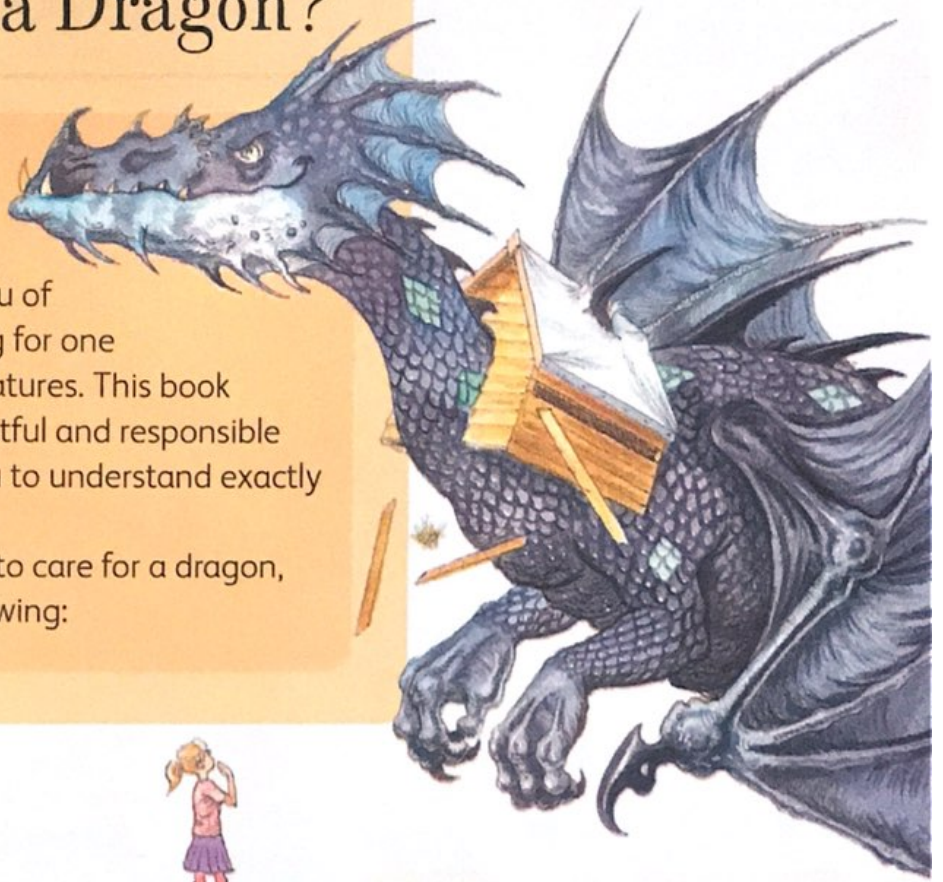


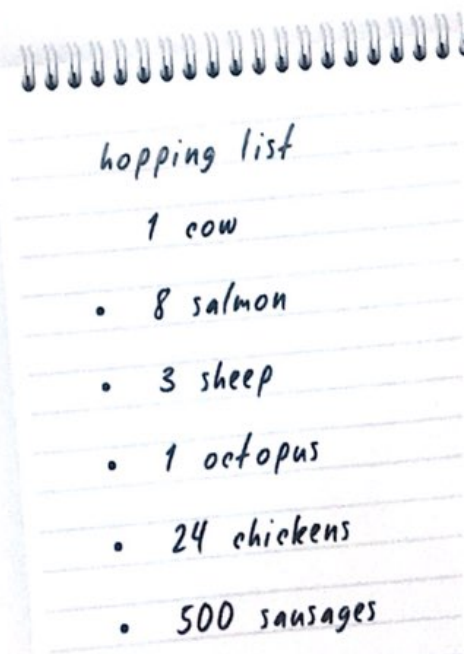
Dare to Care for a Dragon?

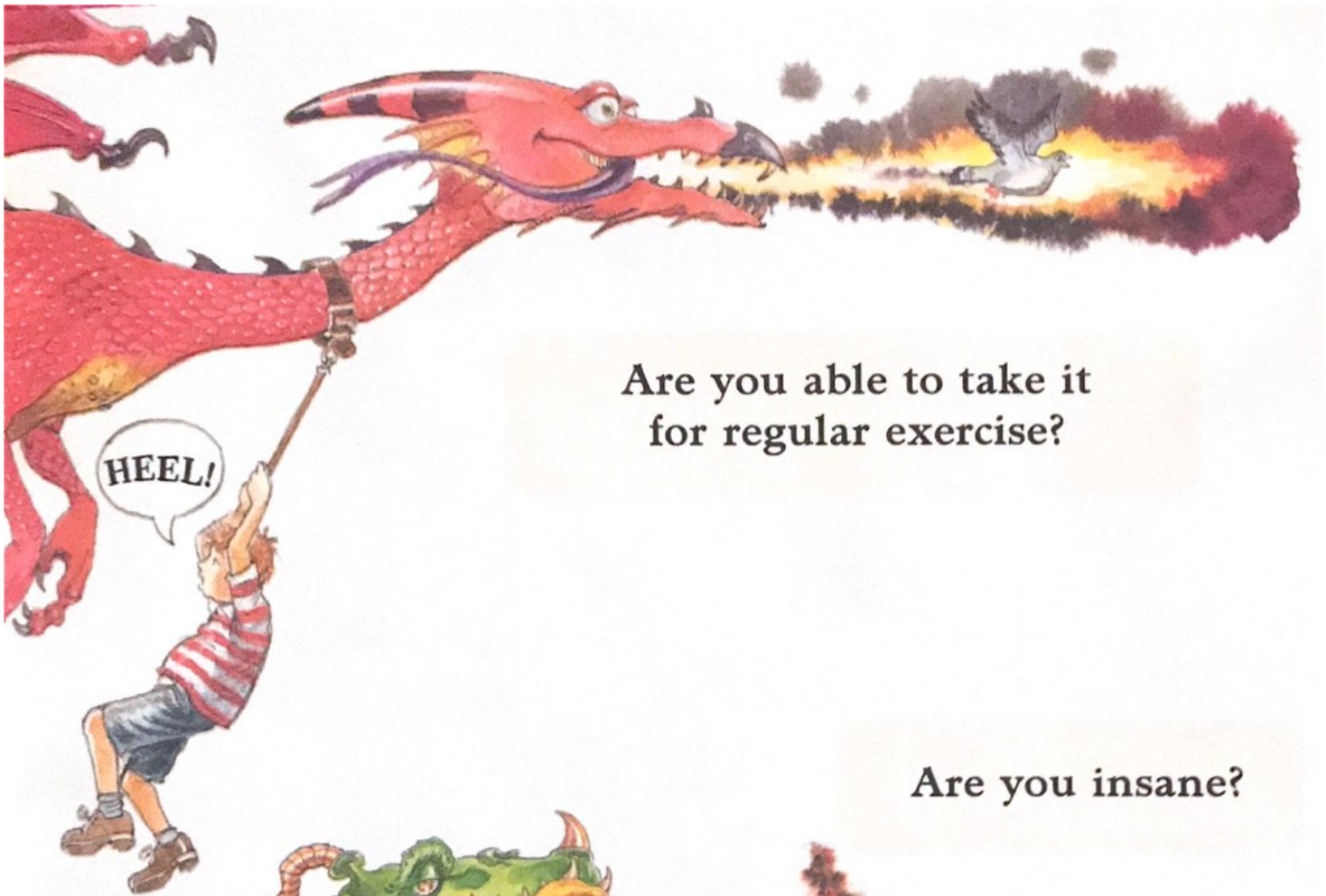

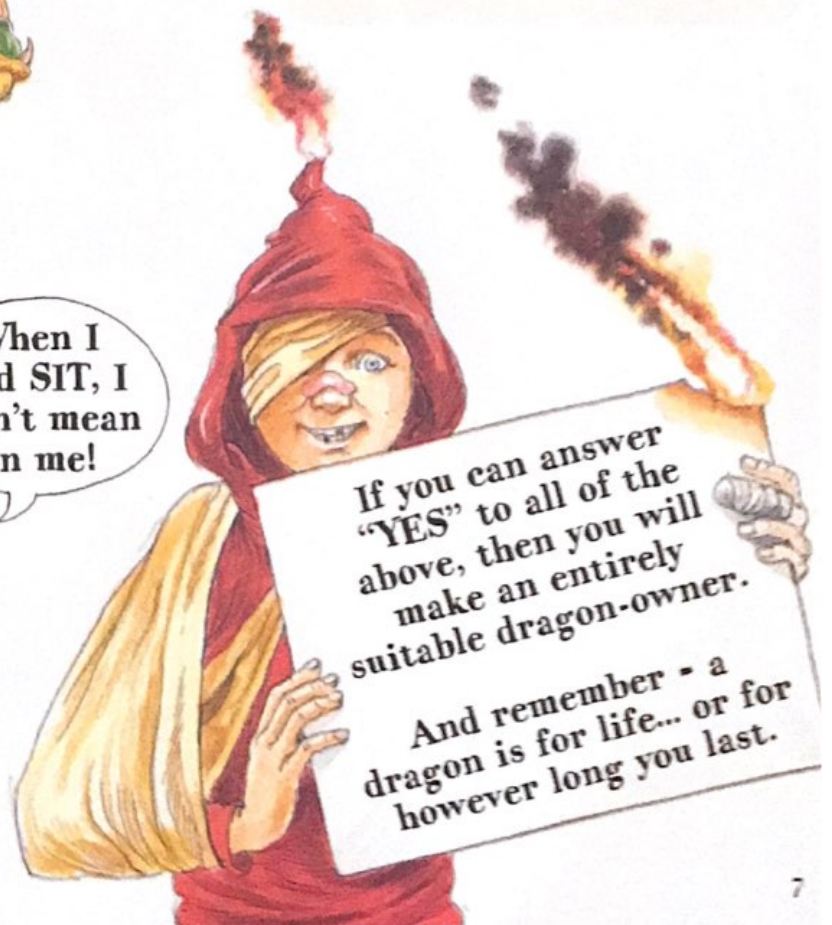
